- The total fee is estimated at \$2,700, subject to adjustment when we make final travel arrangements - group fares usually are not available until six to eight months before flight. If you are selected, a \$50 deposit will be due by the September meeting to hold your place in the group. The balance of the fee will be due in installments from October to June.
- The applicant agrees to live the Scout Oath and Law, to obey and cooperate with Scout leaders, and to meet full responsibilities as a member of the Blair Atholl Contingent.
- The applicant understands and agrees that use or possession of alcohol or drugs by the applicant is both unacceptable to the BSA and illegal in Scotland. Such use or possession is grounds for immediate removal from the group and, if overseas, immediate return to the USA at the applicant's expense. No exceptions will be made.
- The group will meet once a month from August 2025 to June 2026. These meetings are an important part of the experience. **Attendance at meetings should be considered mandatory.** While we understand that a Scout may have one or two conflicts during the year, excessive failure to attend meetings will be grounds for removal from the group.
- I confirm that I have no objection to the information given on this form being held on computer. I understand that photographs and video images of Scouts taking part in activities during the trip will be used for publicity purposes on the contingent website and Facebook group.
- In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the applicant's participation in the Baden-Powell Council Contingent to the Blair Atholl Jamborette, and the activities before and after the Jamborette, any and all claims against the Boy Scouts of America or Baden-Powell Council, or any of the contingent leaders, officers, employees, agents or other representatives of the aforementioned, arising out of any accident, illness, injury, damage or other loss or harm incurred or suffered by the applicant, or to his or her property in connection with or incidental to the Blair Atholl Tour, including preliminary training and travel, are hereby expressly waived.
- It is agreed that the applicant will meet the health and physical fitness requirements for the Tour, including submission of an acceptable BSA Health and Medical Record Form. Applicant agrees to obtain any vaccinations which might be required by the rules of the BSA or Scouts Scotland, or by US or UK government regulations, as of the time of the tour. Applicant will make the contingent leaders aware of any medical limitations or allergies which might affect participation in the touring and event.
